APPLY FOR A BURSARY IN SVGAT'S SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Students attending University, College, or a Trade school in the 2023-2024 academic year may be eligible for a bursary of \$1,000.00 from the St. Vincent and Grenadines Association of Toronto.

ELIGIBILITY: To be eligible, the applicant must meet the following conditions:

- a) They or their parents, grandparents or guardians should be of St. Vincent and the Grenadines descent.
- b) Be a student enrolled at a recognized university, college or trade school in Canada or the United States. Proof of enrolment to university or college or trade school must be submitted along with the application.
- c) All applicants must be Canadian citizens or permanent residents or the holders of a valid student visa issued to the applicant by Citizen and Immigration Canada and be residents of Ontario.

EVALUATION WILL BE BASED UPON:

- 1. An essay of approximately 700 words* on one of the following topics:
 - a) Discuss what an immigrant or diasporic identity means to you?
 - b) Describe the impact of a significant moment in black Canadian history or Vincentian history
 - c) Who is a significant person in Canadian or Vincentian history that has impacted you? Describe the impact they have had on you?
 - d) Discuss what you are going to study and the ways it can help the Vincentian or Black Canadian community

Essay Criteria

No more than 750 words or approximately 4 pages double spaced Font must be Times New Roman in size 12

- 2. A resume outlining the applicant's academic achievements, it should also address any relevant work or volunteer, or community involvements and achievements. All resumes should be in Times New Roman font in size 12
- 3. A one-page cover letter detailing why the applicant should be considered for this scholarship. All cover letters should be in Times New Roman font in size 12

CLOSING DATE FOR APPLICATION: All documents must be received by September 15th, 2023. All applications must be emailed to svgat@vincytoronto.com preferably in one (1) pdf formatted document.
