

HOW TO REACH CITIES AND TOWNSHIPS FOR CHRISTIAN HERITAGE MONTH!

Research and understand the process.

Begin by researching the process of getting a proclamation for Christian Heritage Month in your city. Each city may have a slightly different process, so it's important to understand the specific steps required. Most cities and Townships do proclamations for many events of historical importance. Even if they do not, you're allowed to write to the city hall to start one!

The guidelines and requirements for obtaining a proclamation in your city or township is usually available on the city's official website, or by contacting the mayor's office or city council.

1.Write a formal request.

Write a formal request for Christian Heritage Month to be proclaimed in your city. Be sure to include information on the significance of Christian heritage in your community and the importance of celebrating and acknowledging this heritage.

Examples of proclamations that have been issued in other cities or provinces can give you a better understanding of the language and format typically used in these types of proclamations.

2.Contact your city's mayor, city council members, or other local officials to discuss your request and seek their support.

Be prepared to explain the importance of Christian Heritage Month and provide any additional information or materials they may need.

Reach out to local organizations or religious leaders who may have experience or expertise in obtaining proclamations for Christian Heritage Month. They may be able to provide guidance or support throughout the process. Consider drafting a sample proclamation outlining the importance of recognizing Christian Heritage Month and the contributions of Christians to your community. This can serve as a template for your official request.

3. Prepare a formal request letter or email to submit to the appropriate office or official in charge of issuing proclamations.

Be sure to include all necessary information and adhere to any specific requirements outlined by the city.

4. Follow up on your request and be prepared to provide additional information or clarification if needed.

Stay engaged and communicative throughout the process to ensure that your request is carefully considered.

5. Gather support.

Reach out to community organizations, churches, and other groups who may be interested in supporting the proclamation of Christian Heritage Month. Having a powerful base of support will help demonstrate the importance of this recognition to local officials.

6. Attend city council meetings.

Attend city council meetings and other public forums where the proclamation of Christian Heritage Month could be discussed. Be prepared to speak publicly about the significance of this designation and why it is important for your city. **Start a petition and gather signatures to submit to the local council**.

7. Follow up.

After submitting your formal request and seeking support from local officials, be sure to follow up regularly to see where the proclamation stands and to provide any additional information or support that may be needed.

8. Celebrate and promote.

Once Christian Heritage Month is proclaimed in your city, be sure to celebrate and promote the designation. Consider organizing events, gatherings, or other activities to celebrate the month and raise awareness in your community.

9. Start a social media platform on Facebook and other platforms.

You can name your page/group "Canada Christian Heritage group-your city/township chapter". It is a better choice to align with an organization which is already established since 2018 and currently waiting on registration as a charitable organization.

10. Look for key leaders within your cities and towns.
